Rules of Competition

- 1. There will be only one round and based on the 1st round, the results will be declared. NO further rounds.
- 2. In case of any technical glitch/issue arises during the event, it will be resolved and *further discretion lies with the organizers.
- 3. The time given for elocution is 5 minutes = 3 minutes + 2 minutes.
- 4. Language of the competition is English only.
- 5. Eligibility: All the undergraduate students from law colleges and other stream are allowed to participate.
- 6. Speech has to be memorized. reading, referring the notes while elocution will amount to deduction of marks.
- 7. Participants will be using their Code number throughout the competitionparticipant is not supposed to reveal his/her name.
- 8. Any form of misbehaviour by the participants will be strictly noted and the organisers have the authority to deem any participant disqualified for misconduct.

- 9. Use of derogatory or foul language will lead to the disqualification of the candidate.
- 10. The decision of the Judges shall be final and binding on all the participants
- 11. All the participants are required to have a stable internet connection throughout the competition.
- 12. Registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- 13. In any case, participants are unable to participate in the competition due to poor network connection then in such case, the organizers will not be liable for the same.
- 14. During the elocution, participants will keep their videos & mic switched on throughout the competition failing to adhere to the same such participant will be disgualified from the competitions.
- 15. Organizers hold the power to change the rules of situation demands.
- 16. All the participants will receive the e-certificate of participation.
