## Submission:

All entries must be submitted on/before <u>25th December 2020</u> at the URL - <u>http://bit.ly/TIsubmit</u>.

## **Submission Guidelines:**

- 1. The file must be in .doc/.docx format.
- 2. Language of the Article can be either English or Hindi.
- 3. Each submission must have its own Title on the basis of the topic selected.

4. The body of the submission must be in the format as specified. [Font: Times New Roman / Mangal (For Hindi), Size:12, Line-Spacing: 1.5, Alignment: Justified].

5. Submission must contain footnotes, wherever required. All footnotes must be in the format as specified. [Font: Times New Roman / Mangal (For Hindi), Size: 10, Line-Spacing: 1.0, Alignment: Justified].

- 6. The word limit for the articles is 1200-1500 words.
- 7. An article can be co-authored by a maximum of two participants.
- 8. The file name of the submission must be as follows:
  - a. In case of Single Author '<first name> <last name>' e.g. Ram Kumar.docx

b. In case of Co-authors - '<first name of Author 1> & <first name of Author 2>' e.g. Ram & Alok.docx

9. The last page of the submission must include the following information: Name of the Author(s), and the Name of the Institution.

10. All rights arising from the submissions made by the participants are automatically vested in Editor, Think India.

11. Non-compliance with either of the guidelines mentioned above will result in an automatic rejection of the submission.
